Procedures for a Shareholder to Propose a Person for Election as a Director of Betters Medical Investment Holdings Limited (the "Company")

Pursuant to Rule 13.51D of the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited (the "Listing Rules"), the Company sets out the procedures, as governed by the Company's articles of association (the "Articles of Association"), for shareholders to propose a person for election as a director of the Company ("Director").

According to Article 85 of the Articles of Association, a shareholder (the "**Nominator**") may propose a person (the "**Nominee**") for election as a Director at the general meeting of the Company by lodging the following documents at the head office or the share registrar and transfer office of the Company on 17/F, Far East Finance Centre, 16 Harcourt Road, Hong Kong, respectively for the attention of the company secretary of the Company:

- 1. notice in writing signed by the Nominator of the intention to propose the Nominee for election as a Director in which the following information should be included:
 - (a) the biographical details of the Nominee as required by Rule 13.51(2) of the Listing Rules; and
 - (b) the contact details of the Nominator and the Nominee.
- 2. notice in writing by the Nominee of his/her willingness to be elected as a Director.

Such notices shall be lodged at least fourteen days before the date of the general meeting of the Company and the period for lodgment of such notices shall commence no earlier than the day after the despatch of the notice of the general meeting appointed for such election and end no later than fourteen days prior to the date of such general meeting.

Upon receipt of the above notices, the Company shall publish an announcement or issue a supplemental circular to members of the Company in accordance with the requirements of the Listing Rules, in each case containing, amongst others, the biographical details of the Nominee(s).
